

Announcement of 2022 Scholarships for West Seattle Student Athletes Monogram Club

Background

The West Seattle Monogram Club provides scholarships to West Seattle High School student athletes pursuing higher education.

The Monogram Club will provide \$12,000 for scholarships this year, with individual scholarships up to \$1500. The scholarships can be used at any accredited two-year, or four-year institution of higher education. The awards will be mailed to the selected institutions to defer costs for tuition and fees.

Selection Criteria

- Be a 2022 graduate with at least one varsity letter. If you are a Running Start student, at least 50% of your senior-year courses must be at West Seattle High School
- Plan to attend an accredited 2-year or 4-year institution of higher education in the fall of 2022
- Demonstrate success in both athletics and academics
- Financial need will be considered along with athletic and academic achievement
- Has a 2.5 grade-point average or higher
- Has a good idea of what he or she wants to accomplish in college

Application Process

2. Be available for an interview with the Monogram Club Scholarship Committee on Tuesday, May 17, 2022. Interviews are tentatively scheduled in the principal's conference room beginning at 9:30 a.m.
3. Recipients will receive scholarship certificates at a Monogram Club luncheon on Thursday, June 2, 2022.
